Please note that all health documents are due by October 15th, or your student will be excluded from school. Please make your appointments now, so you have these documents available at registration. Each grade has specific requirements, these are listed on the back of this letter.

- Walmart in Gurnee 847-855-1242 appointment necessary (public aid, insurance, and cash accepted)
- Lind Memorial Dental Clinic 847-872-9227 appointment necessary (public aid & All Kids accepted)

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Health Requirements by Grade

Pre-Kindergarten

- Certificate of Child Health Examination Form o Lead Screening
- Immunization Records
 - o 4 doses of DTaP
 - o 3 doses of IPV
 - o 1 dose of MMR and Varicella
 - o 4 doses of HIB
 - o 3 doses of Hepatitis B
 - o Pneumococcal series or one dose after age 2

Kindergarten

- Certificate of Child Health Examination Form
- Immunization Records
 - o 4th dose of IPV
 - o 2nd dose of MMR and Varicella
- Dental Exam and Vision Exam
- Diabetic Screening

2nd Grade

• Dental Exam

6th Grade

- Certificate of Child Health Examination Form
- Immunization Records
 - 1 dose of Tdap
 - o 1 dose of Meningococcal vaccine
- Dental Exam
- Diabetic Screening

New to the District

Students new to the district, have 30 days from the date of enrollment to submit health documents. If documents are not submitted, students will be excluded until documents are submitted.

New to Illinois Schools

Students new to Illinois schools must submit all health records for current grade and all previous grades. Students in 2nd grade or higher will need;

- Child Health Examination Form
- Immunizations Records
- Dental Exam
- Vision Exam

Certificate of Child Health Examination and Vision Exam must be dated within one year of the start date for that school year and are due by October 15th or within 30 days of the student's start date. Dental Exams are due by May 15th of that school year.
